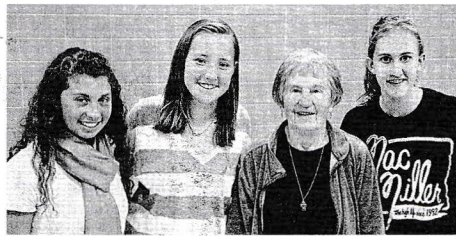

Mepham Spirit — Alive and Thriving

Under the nurturing leadership of Principal Michael Harrington and the strong support of Mepham's teachers, the spirit when you visit Mepham is very noticeable. There are many extracurricular programs going on for student involvement—enriching their lives with experiences they can build on.

In past publications we have written about many of those activities, programs, and clubs. In *Quarterdeck* we wrote of the ELITE (Enriching Learners in Tomorrow's Education) program and Uncovering the Past. In *Scuttlebutt* there have been many. In the 2013 issue we told of the Uncovering the Past's Alumni Breakfast, where seniors sat at tables to interview alumni. This event was repeated this year, October 11, 2013, with alumni from the 1940s through the 1960s telling of their experiences growing up in the Bellmore-Merrick commu-

nity and attending Mepham in its earlier years. Students videotaped their interview sessions to preserve alumni stories for future generations.

Other reports, activities, and articles in the past 6 years include: Chop your Locks for Charity (childhood cancer), ELITE, Pay it Forward, Lipdub, Big History Project, Physics Olympiad, Mr. Mepham Pageant, Mepham Kares, Athletes Helping Athletes, SADD, Habitat for Humanity, "Day of Service," Key Club, Schools Fight Hunger, Poetry Out Loud, The Mepham Project, World of Difference, Culture Club, Gay Straight Alliance, Participation in Government, and Global History.

There have also been many articles on scholastic and sports achievements over the years. Mepham offers a rich environment of activities to report. There are so many ways to keep Mepham students excited and involved.

And the beat goes on... there are always new things coming up. Recently students have participated in the All for Books program to ensure as many children as possible receive books and have access to books. Money collected goes to purchasing more books for children in the Child Life Program (CLP) at Winthrop-University Hospital—turning dollars and coins into books and smiles!

A newly initiated mentor program, Mepham STRONG, stands for Students and Teachers Reaching Our New Goals. Thirty students are being mentored by administration and faculty who have volunteered their time to be part of this initiative. These students meet with their mentors one period a week throughout the year to discuss their experiences and have someone who will listen to, guide, and encourage them.

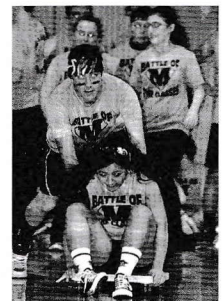


School and class spirit were out in full force for the annual Battle of the Classes held in November. Organized by seniors in the Participation in Government class, led by social studies teachers Chris Patten and Kerry Dennis, \$3,815.31 was raised for the St. Baldrick's Foundation. Last year the school raised more than \$60,000 for St. Baldrick's.

Students in each of the four classes

ranging from volleyball, relay races, and tug-of-war to a pirate relay and scooter race. Seniors were the evening's winner.

Once again, the generous contributions from you, our alumni, have allowed us to continue to support the current Mepham students, the activities for alumni, and the projects that enhance the beautiful building that holds so many memories. 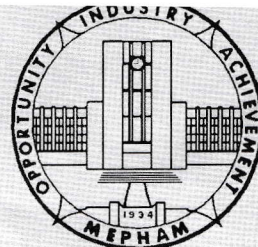

Our new Superintendent of Schools (as of July 1) spoke with enthusiasm about the challenges and his plans for the district. He sees himself as having many hats, the primary one being the instructional leader. He wants programs, throughout the curriculum, from the technical to the arts, to be cutting-edge—for our students

to have what they want and need to be competitive and successful, and for the buildings to meet those needs.

He spoke of the relationship with the community and the unique situation and complication of four school districts feeding into two middle schools, which then feed into three high schools. To make those transitions go smoothly, the slogan this year is "One Voice, One Message."

Mr. DeTommaso is no stranger to Bellmore-Merrick. He was a social studies teacher at Mephram 1988-95, athletic coordinator and coach in that time, was the district's athletic

director for two years, and assistant principal at Calhoun H.S. for seven years. (Incidentally he was followed in that role by our current principal, Michael Harrington). He was principal at Bethpage H.S. for six years (where they have a program quite similar to our ELITE program), then assistant superintendent in Bethpage 4 years before his appointment here.

John was inducted into the National Hall of Fame for Lacrosse and is considered among the top defense players in the history of college lacrosse. A Farmingdale native, he now lives in Rockville Centre and is married 22 years to Heather, a second-grade teacher in Uniondale, has three children—Brendan, 21, is a sophomore at Princeton University where he plays lacrosse, Briar Rose, 17, in high school, and Ailis, 14, in middle school. Both play lacrosse. See a connection?

His enthusiasm for his new role is infectious. We wish him well in his quest for excellence for our schools.

Farewell, Doris Roepke Danderline '42

Doris, after a long illness, died July 23, 2013, age 89. She retired from our board as our first historian. She also served as a Class Representative. She received a Meritorious Service Award in 2005. **Here is what was written at that time:**



"Doris is a great organizer and a self-proclaimed 'neatnik.' She started attending Alumni Association board meetings in 1991, about the time of her 50th reunion. Bothered by the amount of disorganized materials she saw, she asked Denny Ryan, the president of the association at that time, if she could try to straighten things out.

"She went to work, spending untold hours putting the archives of years into a usable, logical, accessible format. She was officially made the organization's first Historian in 1994. Attending a board meeting was a treat when Doris would read a bit each time from her collection, largely about the early days of Mephram. The stories included the rules set down by the first principal, Sanford Calhoun; the arrangements for (and amazingly low prices) of dances and parties; and so much more. Some of that is on Mephram's web site (www.mephram.org) to read. Some of her scrapbooks are still put to use at our table at the Bellmore Street Festival. Particularly enjoyed is the one on the wrestling team.

"When Doris left her position as Historian some years later, she had left her mark. Our archives will never be kept better than when she was in charge. Her time now is spent in quiet activities, playing cards and games with her friends, and watching TV. But her legacy will last as a much appreciated achievement."

More than 2,000 middle school and high school students got a crash course in rugby when Pat Laczkowski, the youth development officer for RugbyNY, taught the basics of the game at each of the five schools in the district, teaching how to pass and receive the ball while running non-contact drills. Pat said the sport is actually safer than football, the level of injuries more similar to that of a soccer match. Saul Lerner, director of physical education, athletics, driver education and health, said "We have tried to keep the physical education curriculum fresh."



On Oct. 17th, 75 students from all three high schools competed in the Bellmore-Merrick Fall Rugby Classic at Mepham. To recognize Breast Cancer Awareness Month, students wore pink shirts during the event and merchandise was sold to benefit the Adelphi NY Breast Cancer Hotline and Support Program.

While the event was a huge success, its future in the district is still undetermined.

The 2012-13 Mepham Wrestling season added to the amazing history of our storied program...season filled with many record-setting performances, outstanding team accomplishments, and most importantly, a return to greatness.

Made the Final Four of the Dual Meet Playoffs, first time since 1998...no doubt one of the best Mepham Wrestling teams of the last twenty years.

Many individual wrestlers had record-setting years and careers: 2012 Nassau Co. Champion Danny Tracy, Outstanding Wrestler trophy at Sprig Gardner Tournament, 100th career win, all-time wins leader in Mepham history (123 victories, two All-County jackets; Jamison Dunn, Outstanding Wrestler trophy at Qualifying Tournament *with a broken hand!*; Louis Hernandez continued his quest to be greatest Mepham wrestler ever, won Alumni Award for Outstanding Mepham Wrestler at Sprig Gardner Tournament, Champion of Champions Award at Freeport Tournament, Outstanding Wrestler Award at Ted Peterson Tournament, Most Pins/Least Time Award at Qualifying Tournament, set Mepham single-season records for wins (51), technical falls (130), tournament championships (8), and takedowns (*a million?*), earned his 100th career win in semifinals of the Counties, won second consecutive Nassau County Championship, became the 11th Mepham State Champion (most in Nassau Co. history), named to the All-Long Island Wrestling team.

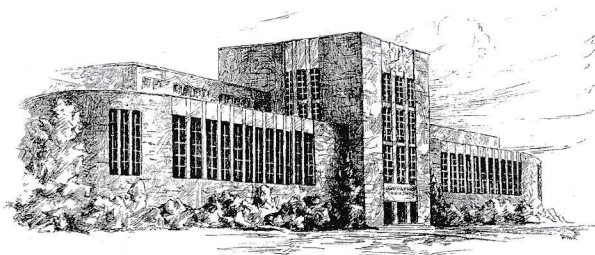

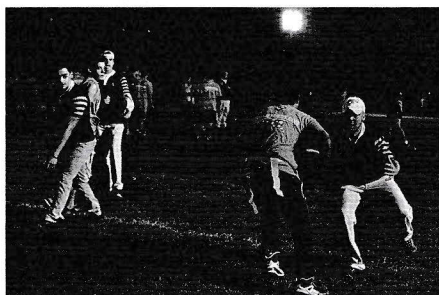
