If you remember your time at Mepham fondly- if it was a place that led to your career, helped you to become the person you are today, and stimulated your interest to continue learning and growing- then participate with us to help keep this association alive and thriving. **Now is the time to give back and "pay it forward."**

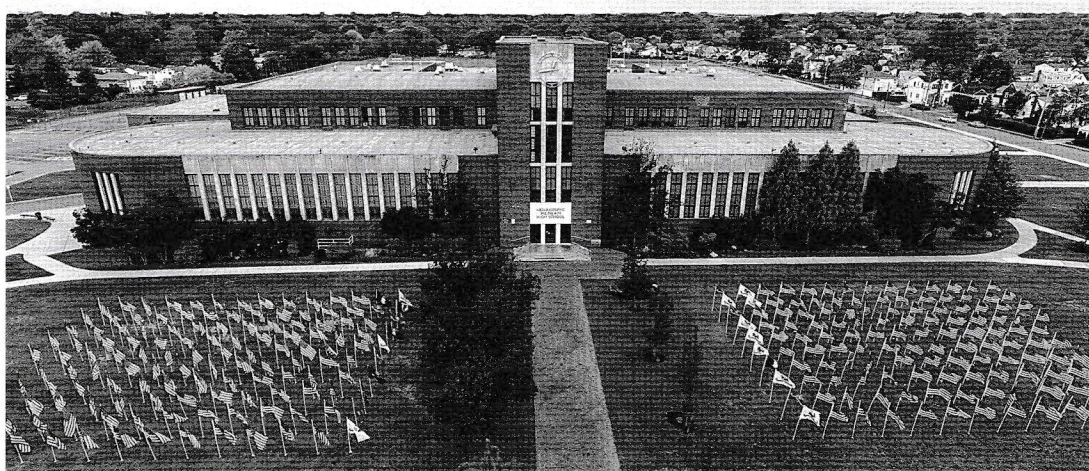

Editor's Note

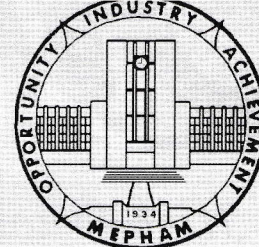

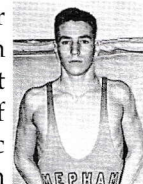

George Munnich, Beloved Wrestler, Coach, Friend

George Munich '54 died Nov. 3, 2015 at age 78. As testimony to the many whose lives he touched, there was a line of over 1,000 waiting to get into the funeral parlor.

George began wrestling at Mepham under the tutelage of "Sprig" Gardner. He went on to compete for the U.S. Merchant Academy at Kings Point, named to their Athletic Hall of Fame. He placed fourth at the 1960 Olympic Trials in Greco-Roman Wrestling. He served in the Merchant Marines and U.S. Navy in the Vietnam War.



He earned a master's degree in secondary math education at Adelphi University and taught at Grand Avenue Middle School for 25 years where he was wrestling coach. He was assistant coach at Bellmore JFK until his death. The JFK wrestling room is now named "George Munnich III Wrestling Room" with a plaque above the door. Coach Brian DeGaetano said, he was "the only guy I ever knew that nobody had a bad word to say about." For over 35 years he volunteered at every free-style and scholastic tournament in the area, coaching, supervising weigh-ins, producing bracket sheets, contributing any way he could.

Parents said "he always recognized the potential in every individual who came out for wrestling and took special pride in helping beginners...he did more for our children than just teach them how to wrestle. He shaped them into men eager to overcome any obstacles they would have to face in life. The lessons they learned on the mat have been applied to real life situations." In 2008 he was inducted into the National Wrestling Hall of Fame.

George was a life guard at Jones Beach and on Fire Island, and was a member of the Baldwin Bay Colony Rowers, a lifeboat racing team.

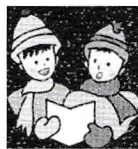
George is survived by his wife, Lilly Ann, children Mark, Jennifer, and Erika, and grandchildren Lilly and Sam.

Over the years, using his vast skills, he became their webmaster, who formed an easily accessible website (mephams.org) that includes over 270 pages and 700 images. He is also the creator of a data base that holds not only the addresses for 18,000+ alumni, but also lists of those deceased, missing, and particular information on many. This he has made available to help board members and alumni who sought class lists, mailing labels, advice, research, and so much more.



After serving 20 years on the board of directors, Jerry has now retired, at age 91, leaving a big spot to fill. He holds not only an award in *Who's Who* for electrical engineering in 1998, but also *Meritorious Service* in 2008. In his career he designed analog computers for flight control in aircraft, co-founded a company that made instruments to test those computers, holds 2 patents, was an independent consultant in the fields of computers, energy law and management, cable television, and electrical engineering. He served New York State in the Assembly as Technical Counsel for the Committee on Energy (1979-84) and as Technical Director for NYS Legislative Commission on Energy Systems (1975-79), where he combined political experience with technical know-how to help form energy policy for the state during the energy crisis of the 70s.

He has lectured in high schools, and in other arenas led discussions on varied topics; helps friends and neighbors solve their technical problems; and more. He now looks forward to a quieter time to focus on more personal issues.

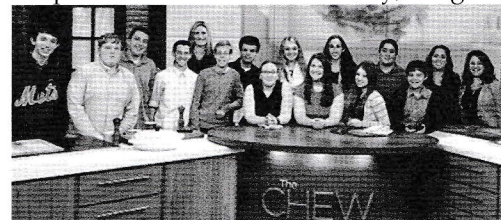

Mepham a "Blue Star School"

For the seventh straight year, the Working in Support of Education Financial Literacy Program (W!SE) has designated Mepham High School as a "Blue Star School. W!SE is a nonprofit educational organization dedicated to providing support services nationwide to help foster financial literacy and entrepreneurship and prepare students for college and the workplace) Its programs are designed to empower young people with the skills and experiences they need to participate in an increasingly complex global economy. It addresses the chronic lack of financial literacy among young Americans.

To receive the honor, a school must have a 75% student passing rate on their financial literacy certification test, achieving an average score of 85% or higher. Mepham Principal Michael Harrington was proud that Mepham students have met these criteria for years and congratulated Social studies teachers Gregg Zomby and Nicole Tschan and their economics students on this wonderful accomplishment.

What happens when you send in your membership forms? There is a procedure. Since we are a volunteer organization, there is no central office crew to expedite your submissions. First someone has to enter the information that comes in; then the treasurer has to collect the forms to deal with the dues received. Somewhere down the line those forms that have information pertinent to *Scuttlebutt* get to the editor. This all takes time.

If you send information you want printed in the magazine, it is advisable to answer and send your form in promptly so I can receive it in time to use because it takes a great deal of time putting together a 32-page magazine, organizing the information on those forms for their proper placement, seeking other stories worthy of our readers interest (such as current Mepham news), preparing photos for print, deciding what will be printed or left out (and where to put it). Since the time it takes from when the copy is finally ready to go to the printer to when the magazine is ready for mailing takes roughly one month, information coming in late can't make it into print.

As editor, I have to stop taking in new, unexpected, material by around mid-May in order to get a disc prepared to go to the printer. I would love to have the luxury of being able to go with "breaking news" but it just doesn't work that way. Every year I have "leftover" information that will either wait a year for the next issue or be discarded as outdated.

So that you don't go into that category, I encourage you not to procrastinate. The news received by our alumni is a substantial part of *Scuttlebutt*. I love reading your submissions, and I hope you enjoy the outcome when you receive your copy. (Remember, only members receive *Scuttlebutt*.)

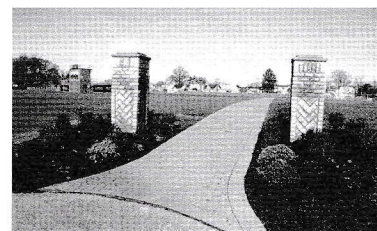

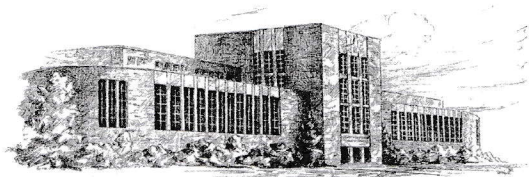
